



COPx contribution guidelines

Who are we looking for?

You. COPx is built on the idea that climate action isn't waiting for governments – it's already happening in your street, your school, your community. We want to hear from the people making it happen. You don't need to be an expert or a public figure. You just need a story worth sharing.

Blog posts

What to write about

Tell us about real climate action happening near you, and how you're getting involved. It might be your community garden that's cutting food miles, a local energy co-op, a school that's gone solar, the neighbourhood repair café, or simply one person who decided to do something – and did. We call these people *climate heroes like you*, and we want the world to know they exist.

Think: *"If a friend asked me what's actually working on climate and wanted to do something themselves, what would I tell them?"* Write that.

Format and length

- Maximum 800 words
- Write in the first person
- Lead with the most interesting thing: don't save the best for last
- Use short paragraphs and subheadings to break things up
- Avoid jargon; if a technical term is essential, explain it plainly

- Link to relevant organisations, projects, or resources where helpful – no footnotes needed

Tone

Warm, direct, and optimistic without glossing over the hard stuff. We're not looking for doom or for spin. Just honest stories about what people are doing and why it matters.

How to submit

Send a Word or other text editor document to community@copx.global with:

- Your name and location
- Your social media handles (if you'd like a mention)
- A headline (max 50 characters)
- Your article (up to 800 words)
- A photo or two if you have them (include any photo credits)

All submissions are reviewed before publication and may be lightly edited. Contributions don't represent an official COPx position – we'll add a brief note to that effect.

A note on AI: We don't mind if you use AI tools to help organise your thoughts – but please make sure the final piece represents you and your authentic voice.
