How to submit

Short videos

What works well

Short, personal, and real. A one-minute clip of someone explaining why they started a community composting scheme beats a polished ten-minute documentary every time. Phone footage is absolutely fine – authenticity matters more than production values.

Ideas to get you started

- A 60-second tour of a local climate project

- A quick "why I do this" message – why you're organising or volunteering in your community
- A before-and-after of a neighbourhood transformation
- A "Do One Thing" challenge – show us your COPx action!

Format guidelines

- Aim for 60–90 seconds; 3 minutes maximum
- Vertical (portrait) or square format works best for social sharing
- Speak clearly and, if possible, include captions or subtitles
- No fancy editing required – just good light, clear audio, and a genuine message

How to submit

Upload your video to a sharing link (Google Drive, WeTransfer, etc.) and send it to community@copx.global with a brief description of what it's about and who's in it.

A few things to keep in mind

- Content should focus on **solutions and action**, not just problems
- Be respectful of the communities and individuals you're writing or filming about – get permission where needed
- COPx is a global movement: what works in one place may not translate everywhere, so share context
- Contributions don't represent an official COPx position – we'll add a brief note to that effect
